**Alutiiq Pacific Wins Security Contract for Airbus Assembly Line in Mobile,  
Alabama**

*Alaska Native company secures contract to provide security for assembly and testing  
site*

ANCHORAGE, Alaska – Alutiiq Pacific, LLC, a subsidiary of Afognak Native Corporation, has won a contract to provide security services for the Airbus A320 Assembly Line in Mobile, Alabama.

Alutiiq Pacific will provide physical security officers for site security and protection, fire and rescue first intervention capability, surveillance, control center operation, entry and exit control, reception, security administration and more.

Work allocated under the contract, valued at approximately \$10 million, is scheduled begin in September 2014.

The site will be responsible for final aircraft assembly, painting, component testing and test flights.
